



## I'VE REGISTERED! Now what happens?

**What's the Board doing?** - Immediately after the last registration date, your Board begins the process of putting the teams together for the upcoming season. When this is completed, the uniforms will be ordered and the coaches will be notified.

**When do the coaches get their teams?** – Coaches should expect to receive their team rosters on Monday August 30<sup>th</sup> at the coaches meeting at Dobson High School. Uniforms should be available Sept 11<sup>th</sup>.

**When do the players get called?** – Teams may begin practice on or after Tuesday Sept 7<sup>th</sup>. The coaches will call the players around Labor Day weekend and give you all the information needed in regards to practice times and location. Each coach sets their own practice days, time and location, usually near Dobson High School area.

**What else does my child need?** – The registration fee includes: complete uniform (jersey, shorts, socks), supplemental accidental insurance, City of Mesa/Mesa Public School fees. You will need to obtain shoes, shin guards, ball (size depends on age) and a water bottle.

**How often are practices and games?** – Practices are held twice a week most generally. Times and locations determined by the coach. Games will be on Saturdays at Dobson HS or nearby parks if needed. Ages 12-13 (U14) will play on Thursday nights at Crossroads Park (Greenfield and Knox) in Gilbert. Older players will be notified of the field for their games.

**Season begins?** – Saturday September 18<sup>th</sup>. Game schedules will be created after registration ends and we know how many teams for each age division.

**It's after Labor Day Weekend and my child has not been called ! –**

Hang loose if your friend's child has been called and not yours. Some older ages will start practicing before others. Some coaches may be out of town. If your child has not been contacted by Sept 13<sup>th</sup> please call our hotline 480-814-8019 and leave a message.
